H. Gentry Facility or one of AIDB's 10 Regional Centers, serving all 67 Alabama Counties.

- 1. We offer partners (employers) a chance to hire some of the most qualified individuals in today's workforce.
- 2. Ongoing support from E. H. Gentry Facility and Regional Centers throughout the lifespan of an employee's time with an employer/partner via:
 - a. On the job training/assistance of employees
 - b. Reasonable accommodation updates and training
 - c. Communication resources
- 3. The opportunity to create a feeder system for a company. Through E. H. Gentry Facility, companies could have individuals trained specifically on processes that would be utilized daily thus, building a hiring pool of individuals with job-specific training.
- 4. Education on Disability Awareness, Accommodations, and the benefits of hiring individuals with disabilities.
 - a. **Disability Awareness** training through Sensitivity Trainings, Lunch and Learn Activities, American Sign Language (ASL) Classes, Basics of Blindness / Deafness sessions, and tours of our campuses throughout the state.
 - b. Accommodations education provided by Job Developers and Assistive Technology Trainers. Accommodations training regarding ASL interpreters, computer-based screen readers, magnifiers, fire alarm systems, services animals, Orientation & Mobility, etc.
 - c. Benefits of hiring individuals with disabilities information through Job Developers and current Employer/Partners. Job Developers can help educate new Employers/Partners on the Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC), resources with the Alabama Department of Rehabilitation Services (ADRS), and other tax incentives. AIDB can pair new Partners/Employers with current Partners/Employers who have utilized services and can speak to the benefits of the program.
